Farwell Village Snowmobile Ordinance

ORDINANCE NO. 63 VILLAGE OF FARWELL SNOWMOBILES ORDINANCE

No person operating a snowmobile in the Village of Farwell may cross US-10 except at the following intersections:

- 1. Intersection of US-10 and Webber Street "By Church of Christ"
- 2. Intersection of US-10 and Corning and Mill Street "By Bank Corner"

No person may operate a snowmobile in the Village of Farwell at a rate of speed in excess of 20 miles per hour.

Any person operating a snowmobile in the Village of Farwell must stop at all intersections, railroad crossings, must obey all traffic signals, signs, and devises, and must yield right of way to all vehicular traffic and pedestrians.

It shall be unlawful in the Village of Farwell for any persons to operate a snowmobile on any sidewalk.

No person shall operate a snowmobile in the Village of Farwell while under the influence of liquor, narcotic drug, barbital or derivatives.

Any snowmobile operated contrary to Ordinance No. 63 may be confiscated by the Police Department. In the event a snowmobile is confiscated the owner of the snowmobile must pay the cost of transportation, towing, and storage and prove ownership of the snowmobile before it will be released to him.

The Village Council may amend or repeal all or any part of this Ordinance at any time.

Violation of Ordinance No. 63 is a misdemeanor.
