YARD & BRUSH REMOVAL POLICY

Yard waste and brush may be disposed of monthly from April 1st through November 30th.

Brush will be picked up on the 2nd Wednesday of each month and/or as needed.

Yard waste will be picked up on the 3rd Wednesday of each month and/or as needed.

WEATHER PERMITTING

Yard Waste

All yard waste must be separated from general refuse and brush and placed within two feet of the curb or road.

Yard waste includes:

- Grass clippings
- Garden waste
- Leaves
- Trimmings from shrubs or bushes

For the best cleanup, please place yard waste in a single row along the curb or road instead of in piles.

Brush

Branches and trimmings will be picked up, with the exception of limbs over six inches in diameter and/or ten feet in length.

Residents who have trees removed must make arrangements for the disposal of branches, wood, and tree stumps. Residents are responsible for the complete cleanup.

If you have not complied with this policy, the DPW will not pick up the yard waste or brush. Instead, they will leave a tag on your door stating why they did not collect the waste or brush. The resident will have a maximum of two weeks to resolve the issue; otherwise, they could be subject to a fine. The Village's goal with this policy is to avoid unnecessary damage to your property and/or Village equipment.
