

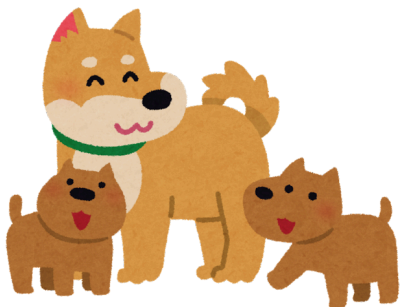

Homemade pumpkin peanut butter dog treats are a great way to keep your dog healthy and happy during the holidays! Here's how to make them:

Ingredients

- Whole Wheat Flour
- Pumpkin Puree – This is good for a dog's digestion systems!
- Peanut Butter – This is loaded with protein and vitamins for dogs!
- Eggs - Eggs are another good source of protein and vitamins!



Steps

- Prep – . Line two baking sheets with parchment paper or a silicone baking mat.
- Make the dough. Using a stand mixer or a hand mixer and a large bowl, beat the wet ingredients until combined. Reduce speed and slowly add the flour, mixing until just incorporated. If needed, add additional flour until the dough is not sticky and the texture of cookie dough
- Roll and cut treats. On a lightly floured surface, gently knead and press the dough together a few times until it comes together. Cut into desired shapes and place on prepared baking sheet.
- Bake. Bake until the edges are golden brown and fully set. You will bake these treats longer than you would 'human cookies'. When done, they should look well past set, but not burnt.
- Allow to cool. Allow to fully cool – the treats will crisp up once they cool.
